## 1. Preliminary Activities. Preparation for the Waste Delivery and Recycling Phase at the Gees Recycling Plant in Aviano

The preliminary activities were carried out to ensure that every technical, organizational, and regulatory aspect of the phases of waste collection, characterization, treatment, tracking, and transportation was conducted in full compliance with the current waste management regulations and the plant authorizations. Furthermore, the preliminary activities took into account the technical-logistical operations of the involved partners or their suppliers to avoid impediments or disruptions during the project's execution phase.

The preliminary activities were conducted in the project Work Packages (WP) concerning (WP 2.1.1) the update and expansion of the Retracking project's waste catalog, which was developed with the contribution of the partners and in collaboration with Veritas. This led to the final selection of specific European Waste Codes (EWC) for the collection and recovery of urban and industrial waste, which was then used for the communication campaign in the municipality of Spinea.

Subsequently, WP 2.3 - D.2.3.1 focused on drafting the activity protocol guidelines, with the document developed by Gees Recycling together with the contracting operator (GRUPPO VERITAS). This document provided illustrative and descriptive support to help the operators of the mobile ecocenter Eco+Eco correctly identify thermosetting plastic waste, while also defining the necessary pre-treatment activities and the documentation required for delivering the waste to Gees Recycling. The final version was agreed upon in a technical meeting held on December 5, 2023.

The Gees Recycling company has thus made itself available on several occasions to provide training support to the contracting operator GRUPPO VERITAS, opening a continuous dialogue channel and offering a variety of options for scheduling and conducting the necessary training sessions. Supporting this collaboration, the attached documents detail the dates, training content, and implementation methods, aiming to ensure effective skills transfer and proper execution of the planned activities.

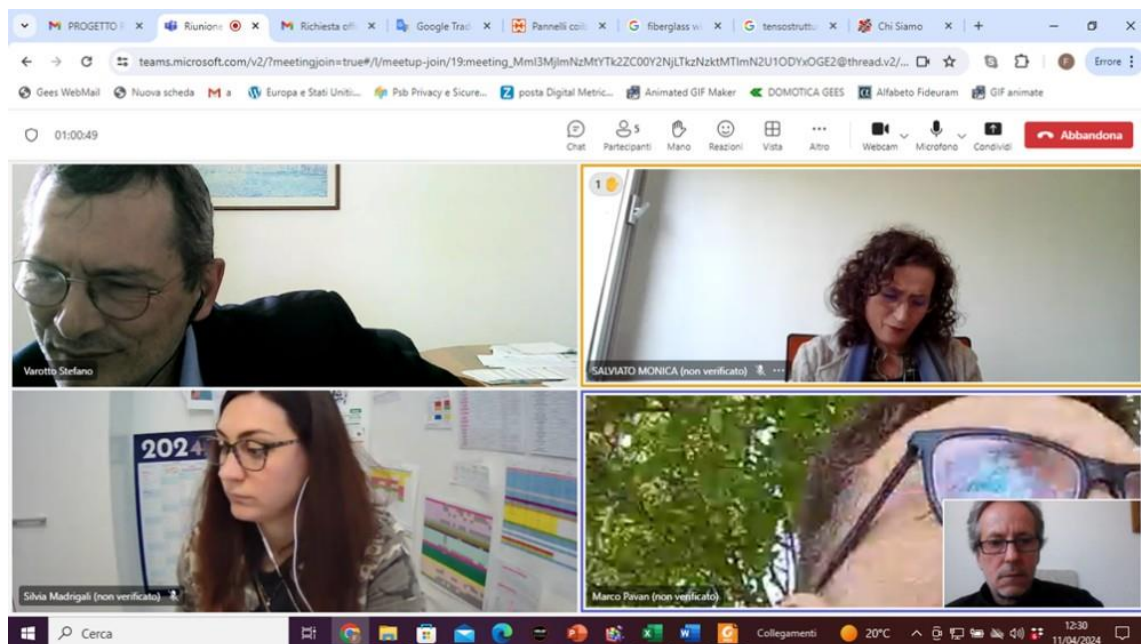

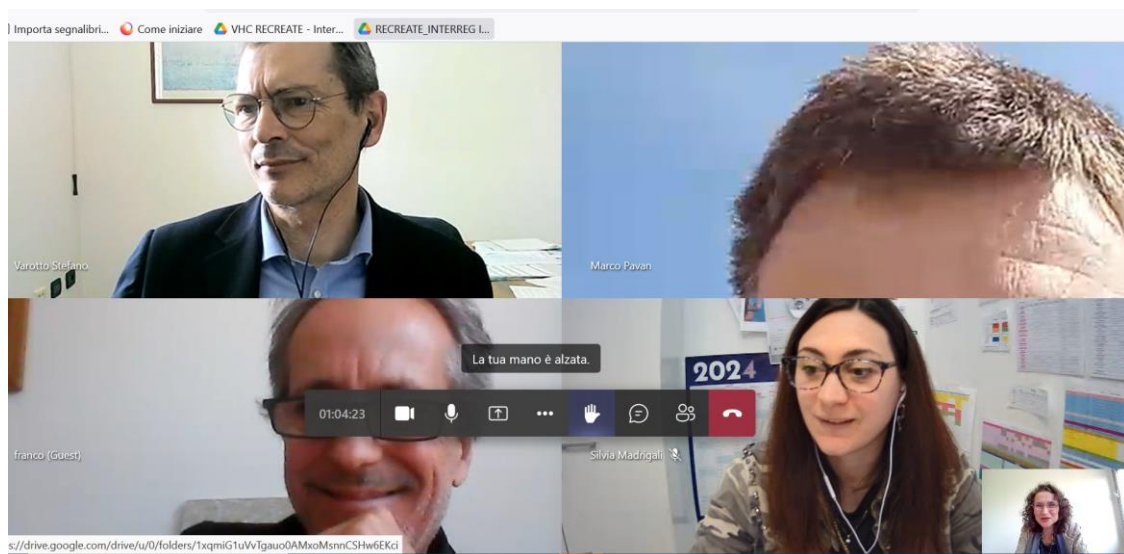

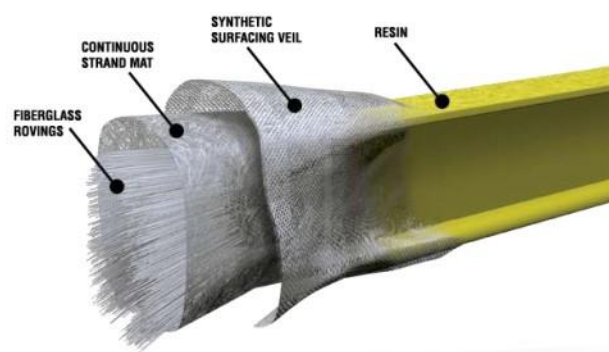

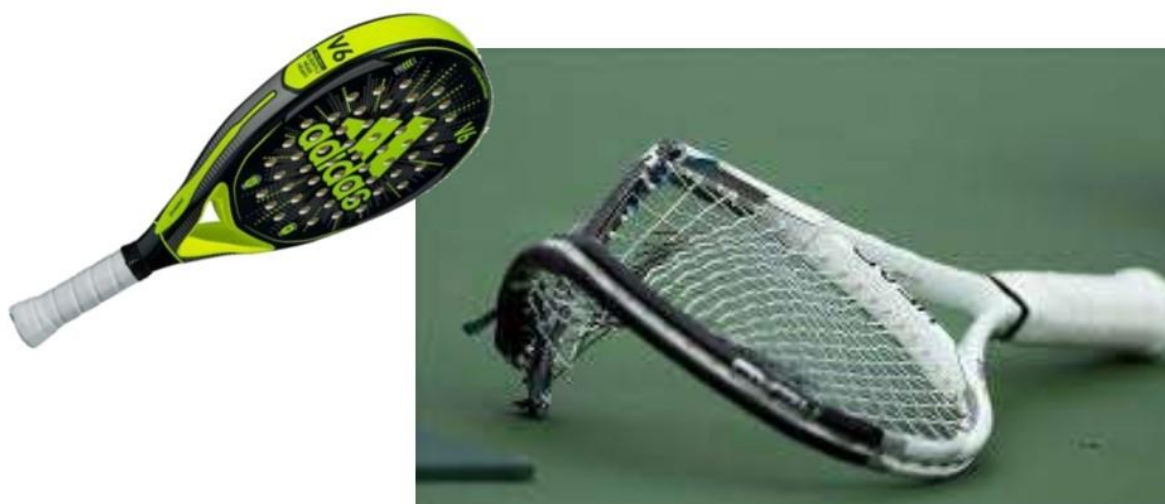

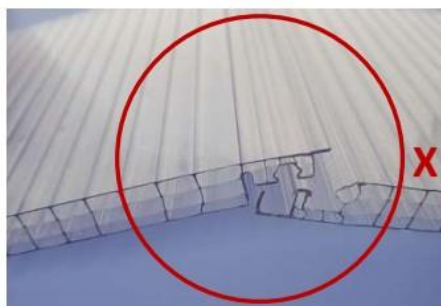
